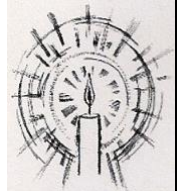

TODAY, 17th DECEMBER, IS GAUDETE SUNDAY *Gaudete* is the Latin for *Rejoice* which is the first word of today's Entry Antiphon. Today the Church looks forward to the joy of Christmas – we light the third candle of the Advent wreath (it is rose-coloured). Today the priest's vestments can be changed for the day from the purple of Advent to rose; true rose is a paler purple, not just pink, and so the theme of Advent is continued.

MASSES FOR THE FOURTH SUNDAY IN ADVENT AND FOR CHRISTMAS DAY (24/25th December)

Please note that the Fourth Sunday of Advent is 24th December: Masses for the Fourth Sunday of Advent do not fulfil the Obligation for Christmas Day, and Masses which fulfil the Obligation for Christmas Day do not fulfil the Obligation for the Fourth Sunday of Advent. Therefore, **9.30am Mass on Sunday 24th December fulfils the obligation for the Fourth Sunday in Advent (or any Mass on Saturday evening 23rd December in neighboring churches: Corpus Christi at 5pm, St Joseph's 5.30pm, Our Lady's 7pm).**

And the following Masses on Sunday evening, 24th December, fulfil the obligation for Christmas Day: Sunday 6pm (Vigil Mass), 9pm ('Midnight Mass') and 9.30am Mass on Christmas Day, Monday 25th December.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION Sessions take place Sunday mornings **after 9.30am Mass in the Parish hall**. Lesson dates: 17th Dec, 7th Jan, 14th Jan, 21st Jan, 28th Jan, 11th Feb, 18th Feb, 25th Feb, 4th Mar, 11th Mar, 18th Mar, 25th Mar, 8th April, 15th April, 22nd April, 29th April, 6th May and 13th May.
