ATTENDENCE AT HOLY MASS AT ST PATRICK'S Due to the current pandemic situation, there are many requirements for the resumption of public worship, many of which may seem rather tiresome, but without which we would not be allowed to resume:

- Holy Water stoups are empty.
- People must provide **face coverings** which **must be worn**.
- **Please arrive in good time**, to minimise queuing outside the church; you will be shown to a seat by one of the stewards .
- Enter by the ramp door. A one-way system will be in place in church.
- Please sanitise your hands on entry.
- Due to social distancing requirements, there is a reduced capacity which is 65. (However, **members of a household/"bubble" may sit together**, and thereby the capacity increases significantly)
- **TRACK AND TRACE: a member of each household is requested to give a name and phone number for the Government track and trace scheme.**
- There will be no congregational singing, and no singing by choir,
- Offertory collections: a collection plate or basket will be on your way in and out of the Church, so you can leave your offerings as you enter the church. (No offertory collection during the Mass).
- People are encouraged to bring their own Missals/tablets to follow the order of Mass. Any printed newsletters should be taken home because they cannot be re-used.
- **Holy Communion** will be distributed after Holy Mass has been completed. People should queue for Holy Communion in a socially distanced manner, approaching the Altar along the central aisle and in single file. Only the priest will distribute Holy Communion.
- Face coverings/masks should be removed to receive Holy Communion and then replaced immediately.
- People should then proceed down to the exit, and leave via the side door in the chapel.
- There will be no toilet facilities available.
- Churches must be sanitised after each celebration of Holy Mass.
- Those who are showing possible symptoms of coronavirus or other illness should not attend.



NOVEMBER MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS: If you would like to commemorate your deceased Parents, Relatives, Friends and all for whom you wish to pray, write their names and place in special envelopes: November Dead List. Holy Masses will be said for them on **Mondays and Fridays** during the month of November. There will be a special commemoration table made available to place your envelopes. Your offering may also be placed in this envelope.

BLESSING OF GRAVES 2020 In consultation with Public Health it has been decided to postpone this year's blessings until the spring when, hopefully, the situation concerning the pandemic will have improved. So, we will instead, this year, be celebrating *live streamed only* for certain cemeteries in November. Masses will be on:

- **Saturday 7th November: Our Lady's, Cannock Road at 11am**, praying for all buried in Bushbury & Beacon Hill Cemeteries;
- **Saturday 14th November: St. Peter & St. Paul at 11am**, praying for all buried in Penn & Wombourne Cemeteries;
- **Saturday 21st November: St. Joseph's, Wolverhampton** at 11am praying for all buried in Hall Green, Bilston, Willenhall Lawn, Bentley, Heath Town & James Bridge Cemeteries;
- **Saturday 28th November: St. Christopher's, Codsall** at 11am, praying for all buried in Danescourt & St. Nicholas' Cemeteries.
- All those buried at Merridale Cemetery (Jeffcock Rd.) will be remembered in the November Holy Souls Masses at SS. Mary & John's.
