VATICAN DOCUMENT “TO RISE WITH CHRIST” CONCERNING THE BURIAL OF THE BODIES. The document is intended to correct erroneous practices that have become commonplace in recent years, and begins by citing our Catholic Faith in the resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ, and in the resurrection of the dead as we proclaim in the words of the Apostles Creed. What is permitted: A body should be buried in a cemetery of sacred burial space; similarly, cremated remains should be buried in a cemetery of sacred burial space. What is not permitted: **The division of the ashes of a loved one between various family members, the conservation of ashes in the home of a relative of the deceased, the scattering of ashes (e.g. across a hillside, in the air, in a garden, or at sea); having ashes set in an object (e.g. a glass locket or some other item of jewellery, a piece of pottery, etc.)**



THE ART OF DYING WELL is a new website that offers a helping hand to those grappling with issues around death and dying. Based in the Catholic tradition but open to all, it features real-life stories about dealing with the journey through death to eternal life. It will launch in November – the traditional month of remembering and praying for the dead. www.artofdyingwell.org. At the back of church, you'll find the prayer cards which feature the traditional prayer for the dying.

PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION (for children who DON'T attend St Patrick's school). Preparation sessions take place on Sunday mornings after 9.30am Mass in the Parish Hall (FHC) and the Presbytery (Confirmation). Children should remember to have their *My Journey to First Holy Communion* booklets signed each Sunday by the priest wherever they attend Holy Mass.
