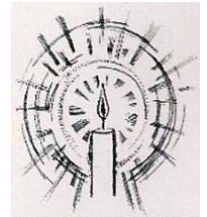

**JUNE IS THE MONTH WHEN WE CONTEMPLATE THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS.** There are several hymns to the Sacred Heart in our Hymnbook, all of which are fine prayers in their own right. They are: All ye who seek a comfort sure; O Sacred Heart, our home lies deep in Thee; Sweet Heart of Jesus, fount of love and mercy; To Christ the Prince of Peace; To Jesus' Heart all burning.

**A MEDITATION FOR CORPUS CHRISTI:** Thou, Almighty Lord, hast created all things for the sake of Thy Name and hast given food and drink for men to enjoy, that they may give thanks to Thee; but to us Thou hast vouchsafed spiritual Food and Drink and eternal life through JESUS Thy Servant. **PROCESSION OF THE MOST BLESSED SACRAMENT** Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. By tradition, a procession of the Blessed Sacrament may be held at the end of one of the Celebrations of Holy Mass on this day: this procession will, therefore, take place at the end of the 9.30 a.m. Mass.



**SS PETER & PAUL** is celebrated on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> June, as the 'whole Church rejoices in the martyrdom' of these two great saints. The opening prayer of the Mass says: 'God our Father, today you give us the joy of celebrating the feast of the Apostles Peter and Paul. Through them the Church first received the Faith. Keep us true to their teaching'. As today's reading tells us: 'All the time the Church prayed to God for St Peter' who was in prison. So let us pray for his successor the servant of God our Holy Father Pope Francis.

**PETER'S PENCE (30<sup>th</sup> JUNE):** The Second Collection next Sunday is one of the oldest offerings in the Church. It is English in origin, begun by King Alfred in Anglo-Saxon times, before the Norman Conquest. It spread on the Mainland of Northern Europe; it is a personal gift to the Pope himself, and is not for the upkeep of the Vatican. The Pope uses it to help his own favoured charities.
