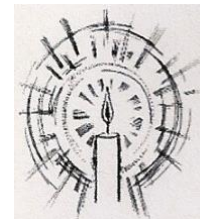

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY DEVOTIONS This Sunday 8th April is Divine Mercy Sunday. This year Devotions will be held at **St Patrick's church at 3:00pm**, jointly for all parishes in the Wolverhampton Deanery. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will start at 3pm followed by reciting of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and reflections from St Faustina's Diary. Confessions will be heard, too. Refreshments will be available in the hall afterwards.

FROM THE DIARY OF SAINT FAUSTINA: One morning, when it was my duty to open the gate to let out our people who deliver baked goods, I entered the little chapel to visit Jesus for a minute and to renew the intentions of the day. Today, Jesus, I offer You all my sufferings, mortifications and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father, so that he may approve the Feast of Mercy. But, Jesus, I have one more word to say to You: I am very surprised that You bid me to talk about this Feast of Mercy for they tell me that there is already such a feast and so why should I talk about it? And Jesus said to me: **And who knows anything about this feast? No one! Even those who should be proclaiming My mercy and teaching people about it often do not know about it themselves. That is why I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. Make a Novena for the Holy Father's intention. It should consist of thirty-three acts; that is, repetition that many times of the short prayer - which I have taught you - to the Divine Mercy.**

If you are GOING INTO HOSPITAL or know someone who has gone into hospital..... The hospital chaplaincy are not automatically informed of the presence of Catholic patients admitted to hospital. Therefore, if you know someone who has gone into hospital, or you are expecting to be admitted, please contact the chaplaincy on 01902 695098 or (preferably) inform the chaplaincy by e-mail (rwh-tr.Chaplaincy@nhs.net). Chaplains are often no longer automatically given the names of Catholic patients. Many health care providers (e.g. Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Mental Health Units) apportion resources for chaplaincy in line with how many requests are made so you are actually doing the Church a favour by requesting the chaplaincy and sacraments whilst in hospital. Please note also that the chaplaincy may not inform Parish Priests about parishioners whom they meet in hospital, or about the well-being of parishioners without the specific permission of the individual in hospital.
