DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY DEVOTIONS Sunday 28th April is Divine Mercy Sunday. This year Devotions will be held at **St Michael's church** (173 Coalway Road, Penn, WV3 7ND) at **3:00pm**, jointly for all parishes in the Wolverhampton Deanery. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will start at 3pm followed by reciting of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and reflections from St Faustina's Diary. Confessions will be heard, too. Refreshments will be available in the hall afterwards.

FROM THE DIARY OF SAINT FAUSTINA: One morning, when it was my duty to open the gate to let out our people who deliver baked goods, I entered the little chapel to visit Jesus for a minute and to renew the intentions of the day. Today, Jesus, I offer You all my sufferings, mortifications and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father, so that he may approve the Feast of Mercy. But, Jesus, I have one more word to say to You: I am very surprised that You bid me to talk about this Feast of Mercy for they tell me that there is already such a feast

and so why should I talk about it? And Jesus said to me: **And who knows anything about this feast? No one! Even those who should be proclaiming My mercy and teaching people about it often do not know about it themselves. That is why I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. Make a Novena for the Holy Father's intention. It should consist of thirty-three acts; that is, repetition that many times of the short prayer - which I have taught you - to the Divine Mercy.**

PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION Lessons on Saturday mornings 11am – 1pm in the Sacristy on the following days: **4th May (First Confessions)** and **11th May.** First Holy Communion: Sunday 19th May.

REMINDER Please remember that Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion have no authority or power to administer blessings at Mass, so, an adult or child requesting a blessing at Holy Communion should go to the priest or deacon for their blessings and not to the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.
