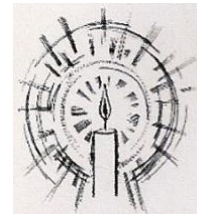

SS PETER & PAUL is celebrated on Sunday 30th June, as the ‘whole Church rejoices in the martyrdom’ of these two great saints. The opening prayer of the Mass says: ‘God our Father, today you give us the joy of celebrating the feast of the Apostles Peter and Paul. Through them the Church first received the Faith. Keep us true to their teaching’. As today’s reading tells us: ‘All the time the Church prayed to God for St Peter’ who was in prison. So let us pray for his successor the servant of God our Holy Father Pope Francis.



PETER’S PENCE (30th JUNE): The Second Collection next Sunday is one of the oldest offerings in the Church. It is English in origin, begun by King Alfred in Anglo-Saxon times, before the Norman Conquest. It spread on the Mainland of

Northern Europe; it is a personal gift to the Pope himself, and is not for the upkeep of the Vatican. The Pope uses it to help his own favoured charities.

GLASTONBURY PILGRIMAGE 2019 The first pilgrimage to Glastonbury in modern times was in 1895 to celebrate the beatification of Abbot Richard Whiting, on the anniversary of his martyrdom 1539 when thousands of pilgrims from all over the country arrived by train and climbed the Tor where Mass was said. Pilgrimages took place after both World Wars by pilgrims in thanksgiving for their survival. This year’s Pilgrimage is on Sunday 14th July and will cost £20/person. The coach will depart from St George’s Parade outside the old Sainsbury’s Car Park (close to St Mary and John’s church) at 7.00 am prompt returning at approx. 8.30 pm.
