PETER'S PENCE (25 JUNE): The Second Collection today is one of the oldest offerings in the Church. It is English in origin, begun by King Alfred in Anglo-Saxon times, before the Norman Conquest. It spread on the Mainland of Northern Europe; it is a personal gift to the Pope himself, and is not for the upkeep of the Vatican. The Pope uses it to help his own favoured charities.

ANNUAL NOVENA TO OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL SUCCOUR AT OUR LADY'S CHURCH, CANNOCK ROAD will end on Tuesday 27th June. Mass Daily at 7 pm (Adoration from 6 pm). Novena Theme: The Eucharist – Sacrament of Charity. In this Novena, the theme is the Eucharist: the Eucharist lies at the very heart of the lives of all Catholic Christians: it is often said of the Saints that though they differ in so many aspects of their lives – whether married or single, men or women, religious sisters and brothers, priests, bishops, martyrs, elderly, children - one thing that all the saints have in common is a love for Jesus in the Eucharist. How important it is, therefore, for all Catholics to contemplate the gift of Jesus in the Eucharist: as we grow in our love for the Eucharist, we grow in our love for Jesus, and we are better able to share that love and that faith with those whom we encounter in our day to day lives.
