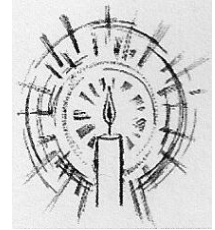

**PETER'S PENCE, 26<sup>th</sup> June:** The Second Collection today is one of the oldest offerings in the Church.
