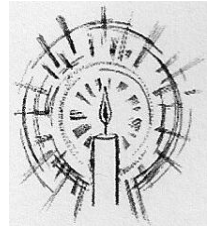

**VISIT OF POPE FRANCIS TO POLAND AND WORLD YOUTH DAY** A group of 150 young people from parishes across the Archdiocese of Birmingham left for Poland last Tuesday. After several days working in one of the dioceses in Poland, they – with youth from around the world will converge on Krakow for some days of catechesis (from Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July- Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> July), culminating with the arrival of the Holy Father, a prayer vigil, and Mass with the Holy Father on Sunday 31st July.
