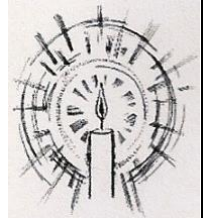

FORTHCOMING CHANGES IN THE PAULINE COMMUNITY As you may remember, Fr. Jan was sent to Wolverhampton for a short period of time. Unfortunately, his time at SS Mary & John's will come to an end soon. His last weekend in Wolverhampton will be 25/26th August and it will be his farewell weekend. After that he will move to Stoke-on-Trent to stay with Fr. Kaz until the end of January. Fr. Jerzy (George) will come from Poland in August to learn English and will stay with us until the end of December. Then he will join Fr. Kaz in Stoke. So, in January our Wolverhampton Community will be made up of Fr. Dawid, Fr. Pawel, & Bro. Rafal. This means that we will have to make some changes regarding Mass/Confession times as it becomes more and more difficult to find a priest to cover Masses etc. Therefore, **Saturday morning Mass at St Patrick's, from 1st September, will be at 9.30am followed by Confessions.** Weekday Masses (Monday-Thursday & Saturday) at SS Mary & John's, from Monday 27th August will be at 10.30am followed by the Rosary. We are hoping that the proposed changes will meet with your understanding as our Order, as well as other Congregations/Seminaries, is affected by the drop in vocations. Please continue to pray for us during this time of change.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS ("RCIA") is the normal way in which adults are Baptised or received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. Following a lengthy period of preparation, it is usual that an individual is Baptised/received into the Catholic Church, receives the Sacraments of Confirmation all at Easter. Any adults seeking to become Catholics next Easter should see Fr. Dawid at the earliest possible opportunity (closing date **end of September**); it is to be understood that attendance at Sunday Mass is expected. Formal instruction will begin in the autumn. Similarly, children who have passed their 7th birthday who are seeking Baptism/reception into the Catholic Church follow a modified form of the RCIA program and should speak with Fr. Dawid as soon as possible.

PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION Information packs, including application forms, for those who wish to prepare for this Sacrament will be available in September. These may be collected by parents/guardians of those who are considering preparing for those sacraments from Fr. Dawid after Sunday Masses during the next few weeks. The closing date for applications is **Sunday 7th October.**

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION Those who are considering receiving this Sacrament should collect an application form from Fr. Dawid (will be available in September). Preparation sessions will begin in the autumn. In the Archdiocese of Birmingham, Confirmation is usually celebrated for those who have reached their 11th birthday (school year 6). Please note: **the closing date for application forms to be handed in: Sunday, 7th October.**

GOING ON HOLIDAY SOON? Don't forget that Sundays are still Holy Days of Obligation and everyone on holiday should do their utmost to get to Mass. Sunday obligation is not just for when it suits us. If you are in any doubt about churches and Masses at your resort, please check before you go. The internet is a most useful tool for this!
