WORLD YOUTH DAY IN KRAKOW Solemn Mass with Pope Francis today at 8.15am will conclude this great



**GOING ON HOLIDAY SOON?** Don't forget that Sundays are still Holy Days of Obligation and everyone on holiday should do their utmost to get to Mass. Sunday obligation is not just for when it suits us. If you are in any doubt about churches and Masses at your resort, please check before you go. The internet is a most useful tool for this!

**REFRESHMENTS & CHILDREN'S LITURGY** have finished for the summer holiday (last tea & coffee in the hall this morning). They will recommence at the beginning of September.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS ("RCIA") is the normal way in which adults are Baptised or received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. Following a lengthy period of preparation, it is usual that an individual is Baptised/received into the Catholic Church, receives the Sacraments of Confirmation all at Easter. Any adults seeking to become Catholics next Easter should see Fr. Dawid at the earliest possible opportunity (closing date end of September); it is to be understood that attendance at Sunday Mass is expected. Formal instruction will begin in the autumn. Similarly, children who have passed their 7th birthday who are seeking Baptism/reception into the Catholic Church follow a modified form of the RCIA program and should speak with Fr. Dawid as soon as possible.

**PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION** Information packs, including application forms, for those who wish to prepare for this Sacrament will be available soon. These may be collected by parents/guardians of those who are considering preparing for those sacraments from Fr. Dawid after Sunday Masses during the next few weeks. The closing date for applications is **Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> October.** 

**PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION** Those who are considering receiving this Sacrament should collect an application form from Fr. Dawid. Preparation sessions will begin in the autumn. In the Archdiocese of Birmingham, Confirmation is usually celebrated for those who have reached their 11th birthday (primary school year 6). Please note: **the closing date for application forms to be handed in: Sunday, 2nd October.**
