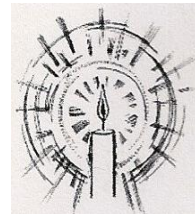

**CHILDRENS' LITURGY** will recommence today, 8<sup>th</sup> September.

**SVP Mass for the Sick** 3 p.m., Sunday 8th September, at St. Michael's.

**EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS (Saturday)** This feast commemorates the occasion when the Byzantine Emperor recaptured the True Cross from the Persians. He brought it back to the Holy Land, which at that time was still a Christian country, and there the Cross was venerated is lifted up for our veneration on Good Friday. This 'lifting-up' exaltation in Latin, is the origin of today's feast.

**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS ("RCIA")** is the normal way in which adults are Baptised or received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. Following a lengthy period of preparation, it is usual that an individual is Baptised/received into the Catholic Church, receives the Sacraments of Confirmation all at Easter. Any adults seeking to become Catholics next Easter should see Fr. Dawid at the earliest possible opportunity (closing date **Sunday 13th October**); it is to be understood



that attendance at Sunday Mass is expected. Formal instruction will begin in the autumn. Similarly, children who have passed their 7th birthday who are seeking Baptism/reception into the Catholic Church follow a modified form of the RCIA program and should speak with Fr. Dawid as soon as possible.

**PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION** Information packs, including application forms, for those who wish to prepare for this Sacrament are now available. These may be collected by parents/guardians of those who are considering preparing for those sacraments from Fr. Dawid after Sunday Masses during the next few weeks. The closing date for applications is **Sunday 20th October**.



**PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION** Those who are considering receiving this Sacrament should collect an application form from Fr. Dawid. Preparation sessions will begin in the autumn. In the Archdiocese of Birmingham, Confirmation is usually celebrated for those who have reached their 11th birthday (school year 6). Please note: **the closing date** for application forms to be handed in: **Sunday, 20th October**.
