PILGRIMAGE OF THE SICK TO THE DIOCESAN SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES AT HEDNESFORD There will be a Pilgrimage led by Bishop Robert Byrne for all those who are sick, their families and carers, Chaplains and Chaplaincy Volunteers and Healthcare Workers and Volunteers. It will take place at 3 pm on Sunday 16th September at the Diocesan Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes in Hednesford.

SISTER DOMINIC DICKINSON RIP (1919-2018) Sr. Dominic, who spent her entire working life as a Sister of Mercy at Our Lady's Convent School, St John's Square, of which she was the last Head Mistress, and at Our Lady and St Chad's, where she was Deputy Head, and was for many years a reader and sacristan at Ss Mary's and John's, died on August 23rd aged 98 years. She is being buried at Fishguard, where she lived in retirement, on September 12th, but to allow her many friends and past pupils to pray for her and thank God for her many years in Wolverhampton, there will be a Requiem Mass sung, in accordance with her wishes, in Gregorian chant at 7 p.m. in Ss Mary's and John's on September 26th followed by light refreshments in St Mary's Hall. RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS ("RCIA") is the normal way in which adults are Baptised or received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. Following a lengthy period of preparation, it is usual that an individual is Baptised/received into the Catholic Church, receives the Sacraments of Confirmation all at Easter. Any adults seeking to become Catholics next Easter should see Fr. Dawid at the earliest possible opportunity (closing date **end of**



September); it is to be understood that attendance at Sunday Mass is expected. Formal instruction will begin in the autumn. Similarly, children who have passed their 7th birthday who are seeking Baptism/reception into the Catholic Church follow a modified form of the RCIA program and should speak with Fr. Dawid as soon as possible.

PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION Information packs, including application forms, for those who wish to prepare for this Sacrament are now available. These may be collected by parents/guardians of those who are considering preparing for those sacraments from Fr. Dawid after Sunday Masses during the next few weeks. The closing date for applications is **Sunday 7th October**.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION Those who are considering receiving this Sacrament should collect an application form from Fr. Dawid (are now available). Preparation sessions will begin in the autumn. In the Archdiocese of Birmingham, Confirmation is usually celebrated for those who have reached their 11th birthday (school year 6). Please note: **the closing date** for application forms to be handed in: **Sunday, 7th October**.
