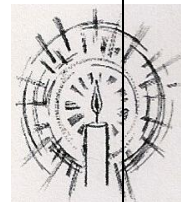

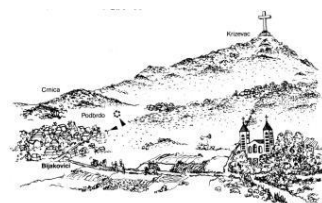
RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS ("RCIA") Any adults seeking to become Catholics next Easter should see Fr. The course for adults will begin on **Monday 21st October at 7.30pm** at St Mary & John's Parish Hall (Snow Hill,

WV2 4AD).

PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION Information packs, including application forms, for those who wish to prepare for this Sacrament are now available. These may be collected by parents/guardians of those who are considering preparing for those sacraments from Fr. Dawid after Sunday Masses during the next few weeks. The closing date for applications is **Sunday 20th October**. First meeting will take place on **Sunday 3rd November 2019 after 9.30am Mass** in the Parish Hall.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION Those who are considering receiving this Sacrament should collect an application form from Fr. Dawid. Preparation sessions will begin in the autumn. In the Archdiocese of Birmingham, Confirmation is usually celebrated for those who have reached their 11th birthday (school year 6). Please note: **the closing date** for application forms to be handed in: **Sunday, 20th October**. First meeting will take place on **Sunday 3rd November 2019 after 9.30am Mass** in the Parish Hall.
