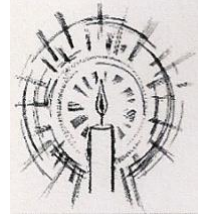

**ASH WEDNESDAY (Wed 6<sup>th</sup> March)** is a day of **FASTING AND ABSTINENCE** from meat. The Law of Fasting applies to all who have reached their majority (that is 18 years of age) until their 59th Birthday. **ABSTINENCE** from meat is binding on all who have reached the age of 14.



**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** will take place every Friday at 7.30pm up until Holy Week. Please make every effort to attend this special liturgical devotion.
